BRAMAH FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

For ROLA C Wooden Casement Window Lock

Tools required

Brace with 10mm (¹³/₃₂") wood bit Bradawl Countersink Pencil T handled 6mm Allen key (R8/01) if required Rule



1 Remove Rola lock A from the threaded insert using a Rola key.

2 Square section frames. With the window closed, mark, drill and lightly countersink a 10mm hole on the vertical section of the window. The hole centre should be 8mm from the edge of the window frame, 18mm deep.

For windows with off square section frames,

the 10mmØ hole drilled and fitted must be parallel with the frame not the window, otherwise screw threads will cross and the lock will not function.



3 Use a T handled 6mm Allen key to screw the threaded insert into the window frame.

4 Fit Rola lock A into threaded insert using the Rola key.

5 Screw Rola lock to frame using screws provided (pilot holes are recommended to prevent damage to frame).
